School Meal Price Increase

As you may be aware, Middlesbrough Local Authority provides the catering service for Outwood Academy Ormesby. The Council has not increased the paid meal price charged to students since 2009.

Following a period of consultation, the Council is now in a position to increase the price of paid school meals. The increase was initially due to take effect from 1st April 2020, bringing Middlesbrough broadly in line with prices charged across the other Tees Valley authorities. However, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, this increase was delayed and will now commence from 1st September 2020. Moving forward prices will rise annually at the rate of inflation.

Current Meal Price: £2.00

New Meal Price: £2.15

Please be advised that the biometric and payment methods will be adjusted accordingly to reflect this new price increase.

Students entitled to free school meals will not be affected by this increase.
